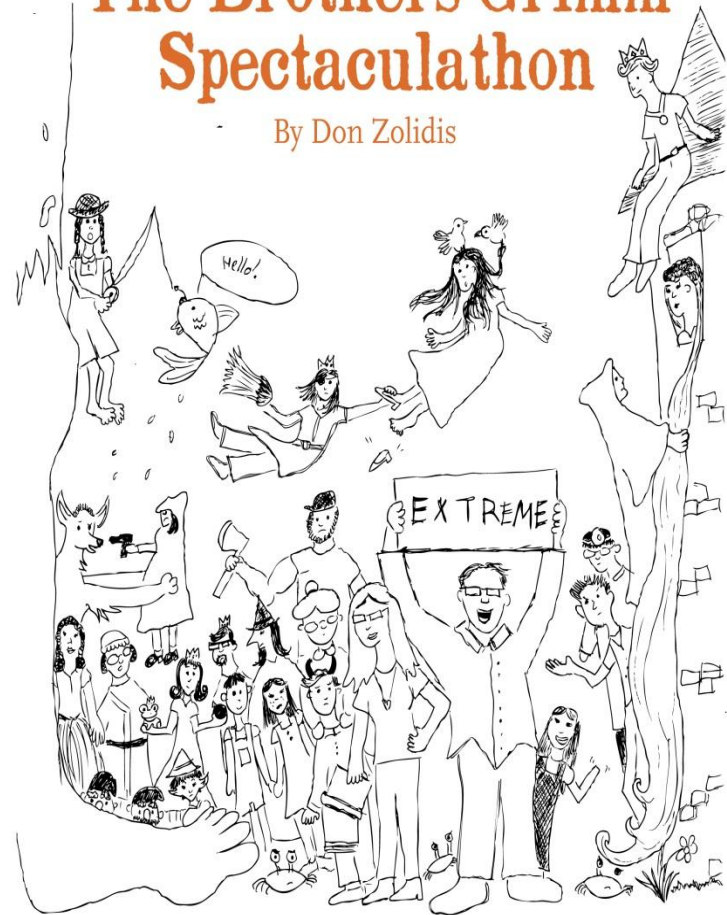

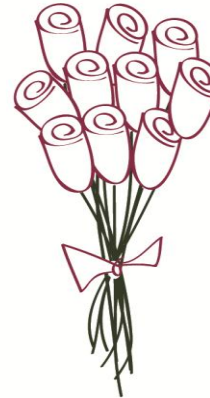

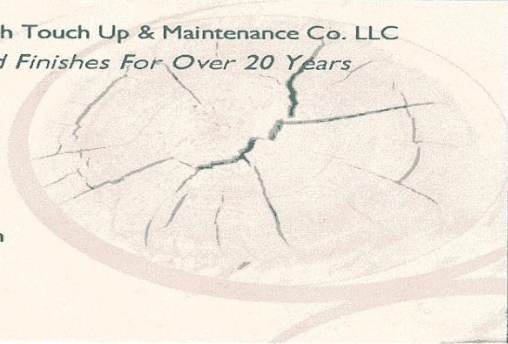
Witness for the Prosecution (January 2013)

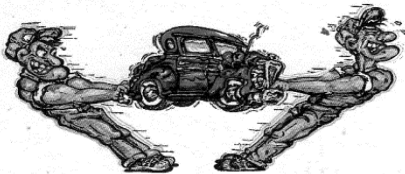
